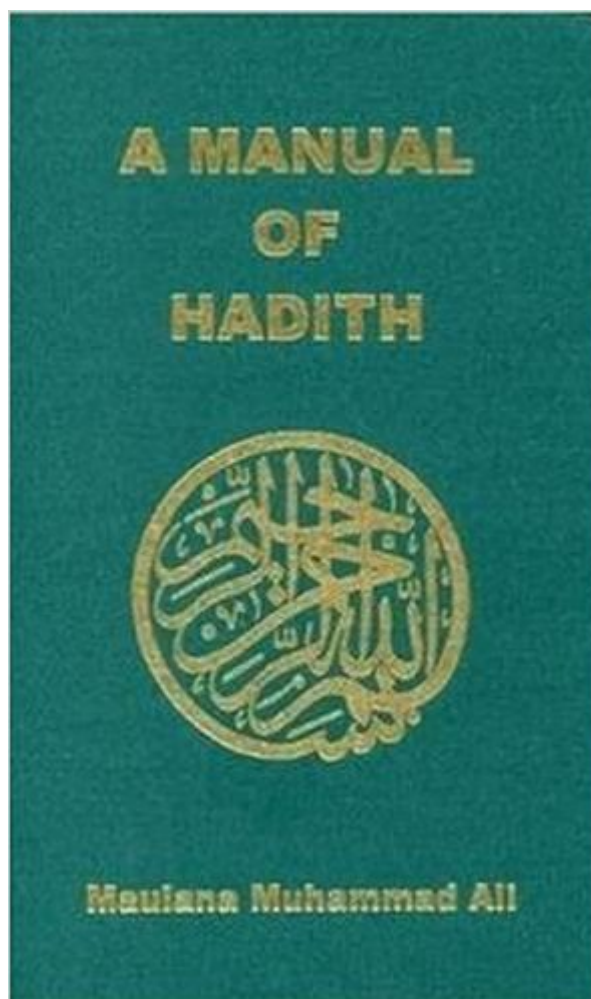

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Customer Reviews

I wanted to write a review on this book, as I own it myself. To simplify the arguments that have been presented regarding this book, I wanted to add my two cents. The author was a prolific writer who was part of what is called the Ahmadiyya movement. Without arguing in detail, I want to give a brief explanation of the concerns others have raised. As a revert myself, I was cautioned by a Hanafi Sheikh about this movement. This is not done to be argumentative or an online jihadi or anything like that, but simply because the founder of the Ahmadiyya movement made claims that brought the movement dangerously close to if not outside the fold of Islam. Ghulam Ahmad is purported to have claimed to be a prophet after the Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him); I have read responses saying that he did not claim such a thing. Others have stated that he claimed to be the Madhi; his supporters argued that he only claimed to be a reviver. I cannot speak for his intentions, and I would never presume to say who is and who is not a Muslim. Only Allah can judge. The caution that I would extend is that there are beliefs espoused by the Ahmadiyya movement that are questionable in light of Qur'an and Sunnah. BUT, and this is the most important thing I can say: I am not a scholar. I do not speak Arabic, but I can say that I have found nothing that deviates from the Sahih Hadith collections of Imam Bukhari or Imam Muslim. In light of that, this book is purely a sampling of Hadith. It does not include commentary by the author. Many have stated that with so many good translations out there that it would be better to go with them. I am inclined to agree with this. For anyone new to Islam or who is curious about the faith, the works of Imam Bukhari and Imam Muslim

are considered the most authentic.

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
